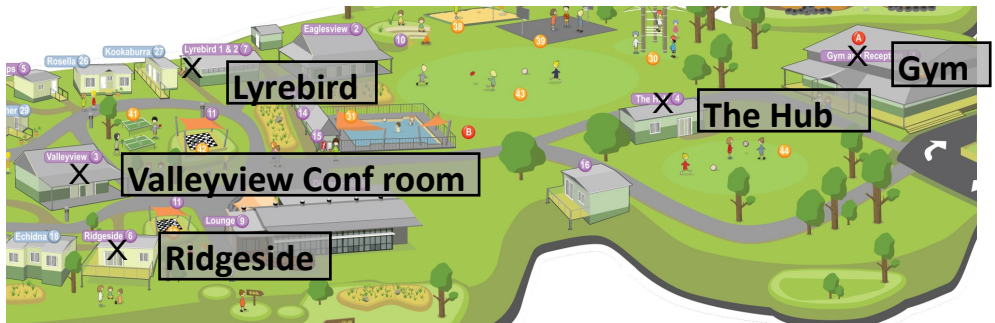

Who is central to the new creation? Who will be a part of the new creation?

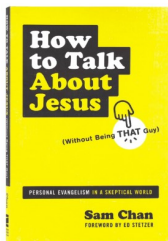
Who will not? How should we live today in light of these things?

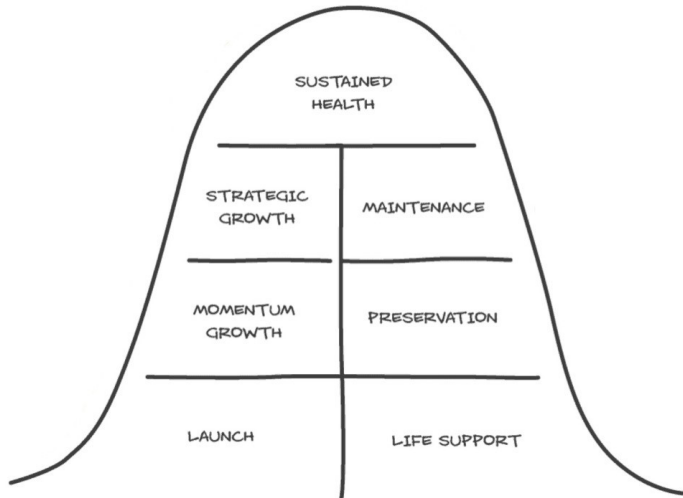

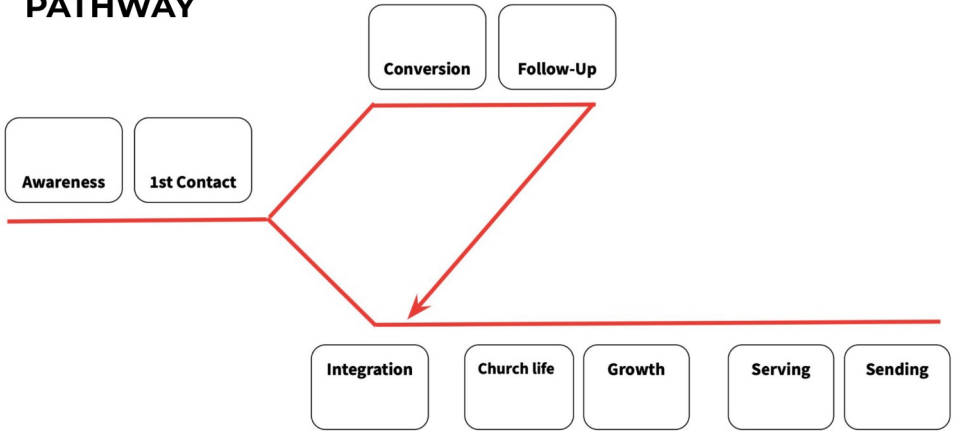

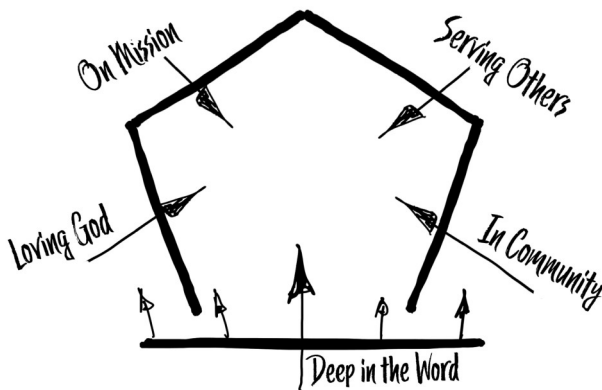
